



## MERCHANDISER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read these **Terms and Conditions** carefully.

By securing a Merchandise Site, you are agreeing to be bound by the following terms and conditions.

1. The final placement of all merchandisers is at the discretion of NTMEC.
2. A copy of your certificate for your public liability insurance for an amount not less than \$20 million is to be supplied with your application.
3. Leads and equipment need to meet Australian Standard 3760 relating to the testing and tagging of all equipment. Event electricians will be unable to assist with testing and tagging.
4. Vehicles including but not limited to golf buggies and quad bikes must be registered and meet roadworthy requirements. Temporary vehicle registrations are available through the Northern Territory Department of Transport's Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR).
5. The Merchandiser shall at their own cost and expense observe, comply with and direct all things within their power and ability to ensure that they, their staff and customers, comply with and observe all present and future legislation affecting the operation of the stall, and they and their staff comply with all statutory or public authority notices served or received from the relevant authority or NTMEC, including but without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
  - 5.1 Local Government Act and any Regulations or By-Laws made thereunder,
  - 5.2 The Health Act and any Regulations made thereunder,
  - 5.3 The Fire Service Act and any Regulations made thereunder,
  - 5.4 Any permits licenses or authorities granted to the permit holder or which the permit holder may be obliged or required to maintain and any directions, requirements and stipulations made and given under any of the above-mentioned Acts or Regulations.
6. The Merchandiser acknowledges that it is responsible for its own security and property, and that of its employees, officers, contractors and agents at the Event.
7. Merchandisers are not permitted to camp or sleep on site within Hidden Valley Motorsport Complex during bump in and/or the event weekend. If any persons are found sleeping on site they will be asked to leave the premises immediately and may have their accreditation removed.
8. Merchandisers must remain on their allocated site and are not permitted to undertake ambush marketing activities outside of their allocated site.
9. All site fees must be paid in full paid before Merchandisers can collect their passes.
10. Each site fee includes two Merchandiser trade passes to access the venue and one Merchandiser car pass, additional passes may be purchased.
11. Car passes must be affixed to the windscreen of your nominated vehicle. Vehicles with car passes not affixed to windscreens will be turned away.
12. Merchandisers need to supply their own waste bins and liners and are responsible for their own clean up. Bags must be placed in the supplied bins in readiness for collection.
13. NTMEC will supply a list of endorsed contractors; these should be supported where possible.
14. All speed limits must be obeyed and vehicles need to be aware of pedestrians. The speed limit in no more than 10kph at all times in the paddock. Hazard lights must be turned on while driving in the paddock. The speed limit throughout the rest of the Hidden Valley Motorsport Complex is 40kph – PEDESTRAINS have right of way ALWAYS.
15. Merchandisers wanting to store containers on site need to liaise with NTMEC in regards to placement.
